
Sampling of sports outreach programs started by GSSM students.

- ✓ Kabale, Uganda student: initiates under 13 soccer outreach program. Had little equipment, raised funds for uniforms, entered team in local tournament, made it to the quarterfinals. GOAL: Reach these young boys for Christ, disciple them, train them to evangelize and disciple and take them to nearby towns and villages to share their faith.
- ✓ Togo, Africa student: church is sponsoring a series of sports outreach programs in several villages located 90km from students home in Lome, the capital. Will use soccer and other sports to share the Gospel. Huge potential to reach many for Christ and start new programs in the villages.
