
# Recap of the 2015 Student Evaluation Trip

### Third Stop - Kabale

- In Kabale our main objective was to meet one on one with the students from the 2013-2015 class and administer their final oral and written exams.
- During the course of this two-day period we met with almost all our students from this area.
- We were able to meet one on one and administer the oral exam and hear what they have learned and what they are doing in ministry. Honestly, this is one of my favorite things! I love hearing what God is doing in & through them!

After the exams were completed we had the privilege of seeing a ministry that three students have started together, a soccer league in a remote village outside of Kabale. We were able to observe how they ran it, shared the Gospel and lastly were able to give them some constructive suggestions and encouragement and most importantly pray over them.
