When the second term is completed, GSSM will have placed 40 sports minsters in the field for the same amount of money since each program initiated by our students is sustained by the local church and other believers in the region in which the graduate will be working.

Although unbelievable, it gets progressively better!

With each succeeding graduating class, the numbers continue to increase exponentially. In a relatively short period of time, GSSM will be able to place hundreds of sports ministers in countries around the world for less than it takes to support one western worker in Africa.

A select number of GSSM graduates will become trainers of others. GSSM will equip these special students to become instructors and provide a seed grant to get them started. GSSM will also provide textbooks and other resource materials as they launch their training program. In addition, GSSM will continue to serve as consultants and assist as needed.

JIMMY - Uganda

Established programs in 2 large slums in Kampala. Includes sports programs for over 350 youth. Feeds 300 children daily. Developed children's choir who sing and share the Good News in the 2 slums and in churches. Trains and sends out some youth soccer teams who share the Good News to schools within walking distance (up to 5 miles). Developing a half-way home for orphans in the 2 slums. Counsels Aids victims. Self-sustaining.

HENRY - Malawi

A pastor who has established soccer programs for 120 young men and who is now forming a girls' program as well. Henry is also training other pastors and youth leaders in Malawi and Zambia and is helping them to get started. Totally self-sustaining.

WELLINGTON - Liberia

Has established sports ministry programs through his church in Monrovia (Capital of Liberia). Will soon be training others. Wellington pastors a large church, oversees other churches and teaches in a seminary. Currently helping Ebola victims. Self-sustaining.

PHIL - Mexico

American missionary recently enrolled in GSSM.

Will be establishing sports ministry programs early in 2015 in order to help plant several churches in Mexico. Self-supporting.
