I even personally invited every male student at Westmont to turn out for the team if they so desired. Amazingly, 105 men showed up for our pre-season training in the fall eager to be a part of the team and share in the success our teams were enjoying.

After just one day of our 3-A-Day pre-season workouts, only 75 reported for Day #2. By the end of our 3<sup>rd</sup> day we were down to 50 aspiring athletes. Two days later our numbers had dropped to 30 and about now I had the kind of players I wanted for our varsity and Jr. varsity teams. These were the ones who were serious and willing to pay the price to be part of our team. They were a little like the Navy Seals. Tough, determined, wouldn't give up...men you could count on.
