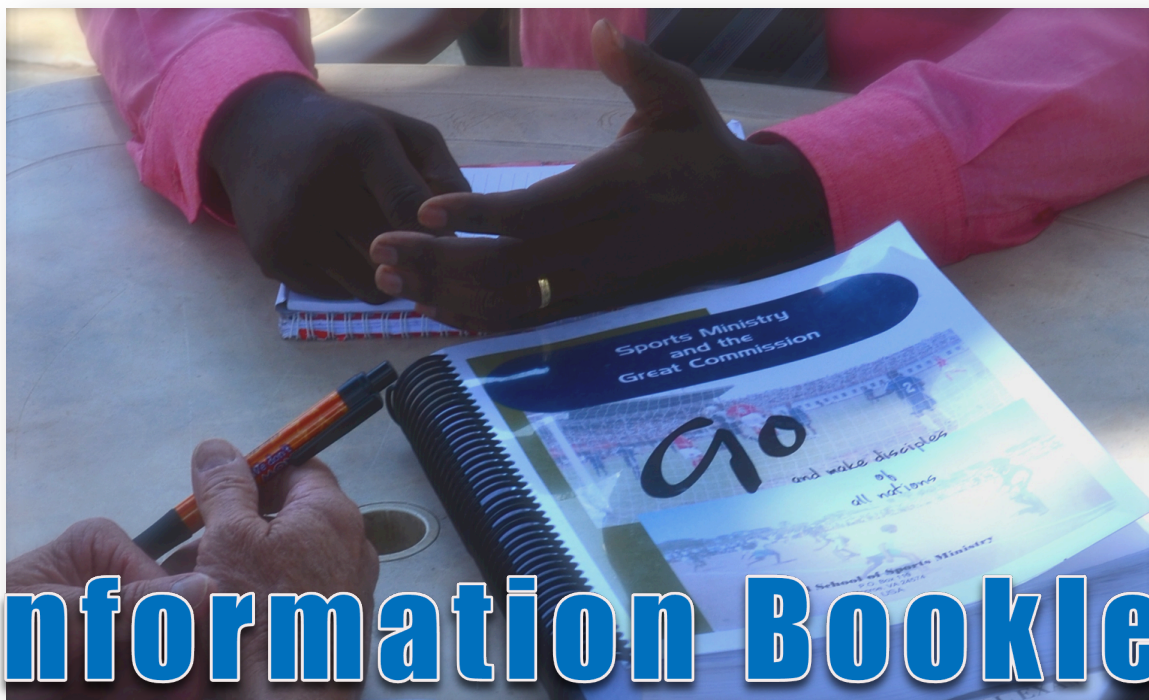

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Global School of Sports Ministry

IN BRIEF

GSSM is a training program that uses online instruction coupled with selected practicums to equip dedicated men and women to become sports ministry leaders.

In order to successfully complete the course, each student must initiate and maintain a sports outreach program through their local church for a period of three or more years. All programs must be self-sustaining.

GSSM will continue to monitor, encourage, consult and, when appropriate, send mission teams to assist and give credibility to the new programs initiated by the GSSM students.

GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

1. Successfully complete the 18-month online course.
2. Participate in one or more practicums organized and supervised by GSSM personnel.
3. Initiate a sports ministry program through the students local church and maintain it for three or more years.

SUPPORT FOR GSSM

Financial support for GSSM comes from several evangelical churches, foundations, organizations and principally from individual donors.

TAX DEDUCTIBLE

Global School of Sports Ministry is incorporated in the Commonwealth of Virginia as a non-profit and is designated as a 501 (c) (3) under the Internal Revenue Service (IRS) code. Donations are tax deductible.

FACTS at a Glance

- **PURPOSE**

To train prospective sports ministry leaders in the effective use of sports as a tool of evangelism and discipleship with an emphasis on discipleship.
- **GOAL**

To initiate effective, viable sports ministry programs around the world in order to fulfill Christ's command to go and make disciples of all nations.
- **HOW**

A distance learning program that is individually paced is being offered over the internet or through traditional correspondence by post. On-site instruction and consultation available throughout the year for all students and churches.

Each potential sports minister will be required to initiate a sports ministry program in his or her region in order to complete the practicum aspect of the curriculum. The student commits to running the program for a period of 3 or more years. Each program must be self-sustaining.
- **COOPERATIVE PHILOSOPHY**

Global School of Sports Ministry will network with other Christian agencies and organizations to enhance the training program.

- **LIMITED ENROLLMENT**

All applicants will be carefully screened before being admitted to Global School of Sports Ministry. The number of students will be limited in order to insure a quality education and allow for individual attention.
- **LENGTH OF COURSE**

The basic course will take eighteen months to complete. Students who successfully pass the basic course will have the option to extend their studies in order to obtain an advanced diploma.
- **PRACTICUMS**

Each student will be asked to participate in one or more of the practicums directed by GSSM staff. These will serve to help the student better understand the organization and implementation of outreach programs prior to beginning a program of their own.
- **COST**

Scholarships for students from developing countries are available and will cover most of the costs associated with the training program. However, each student must submit a \$25 or equivalent application fee in order to enroll. This fee will be refunded to all students from developing countries who successfully complete the course of study. Students from developed countries will be assessed a \$100 non-refundable application fee.
- **OVERSIGHT**

A board of directors from Global School of Sports Ministry will provide general oversight for the program. Specific assistance will be provided by board members with expertise in education.
- **NON-DENOMINATIONAL**

Global School of Sports Ministry is non-denominational and is supported by a number of evangelical churches, organizations and individuals.

Sports ministry, simply defined, is any program or strategy that uses sports as a vehicle to fulfill Christ's command to go into all the world and make disciples of all nations. It is using sports to evangelize and disciple with the emphasis on making disciples.

STATEMENT OF FAITH

The Journey of a GSSM Student

From Matriculation to the Harvest Fields

1. Students apply on-line or by post.
2. Applicants are carefully screened, references checked
3. Admissions Committee prayerfully reviews each application. Prospective students meeting GSSM's high standards are admitted, given a GSSM textbook and set of instructions that will guide them throughout the 18 month training program.
4. Instructors are assigned and introduced to each of the students.
5. Online lessons are then sent to teach student, one lesson per month. Lessons are graded by instructors and comments are sent to the students with a copy to GSSM's administration to be filed in the students folder. Information is also charted by GSSM's administration as a tracking device. Students without computers use the postal system as in the old correspondence courses.
6. Students successfully completing their studies and all other graduation requirements including the passing of oral and written final examinations, the verification of the establishment of a successful sports ministry program through the students local church or a church "plant" will then be eligible to graduate.
7. The final step in the progression of a GSSM student is the awarding of a diploma which is generally presented at a church service in the students church. In addition a sports ministry kit is given to each graduate. The kit contains a study Bible for the graduate, Bibles, New Testaments, Gospels of John, Gospel tracts, discipleship materials, sports equipment, GSSM shirt, cap, whistle, clipboard, a ball, etc...

THE RESULTS

1. Graduates commit to running their sports outreach programs for 3 or more years. All programs must be self-sustaining. GSSM will continue to serve as consultants for our graduates, offer independent study courses to meet special needs or interests and will, on occasion, send short-term mission teams from the U.S. or other locations to help give additional assistance and credibility to the students program.

2. Exceptional students who develop extraordinary model programs will receive further training and some assistance as warranted. Two examples follow and are featured in the enclosed newsletters or can be found on our website by using the two links listed below:
